The Cleveland Metroparks encircles our city with 23,000 acres of green space, including 18 reservations, eight lakefront parks and 3,000 miles of trials - and countless recreational choices for residents. In downtown Cleveland and along Ohio's north coast, 70 public beaches are a spectacular way to experience Lake Erie, the 11th-largest freshwater lake in the world.

Towpath Trail

The Towpath Trail bikeway follows the historic Ohio & Erie Canal. This multi-purpose trail will run from the Lake Erie shore through Cuyahoga Valley National Park and more than 101 miles into southern Ohio. This trail has become a backbone of future bikeways helping make our region more bike friendly.


SkillUp Talent Services


SkillUp is a free business advisory service offered by the Cuyahoga County Department of Economic Development that helps companies identify business problems, create solutions, and drive business results.




